- Co-Finance Organisations and Prime Contractors
- Community Grants
- Technical Assistance





Direct Bidding

- Publicise bidding rounds
- Many bids
- Eligible
 - (and hurdles)
- Quality (score)
 - (and cut off)
- Fund highest scores





Co-Finance Organisations and Prime Contractors

- CFO Select a few Government organisations
- Primes Competition for a few large organisations
- Then sub-contract some activity
- Less administration for the Member State
- More administration for NGOs
- Higher risk





Community Grants

- One organisation provides the match
- Simple application process
- Rapid decision making (4-8 weeks)
- Maximum bid (€5,000 to €10,000)
- Signposting





Technical Assistance

- Specifically to support NGOs
 - (but can be used for other Partners)
- Higher intervention rate for NGOs
- Information, Representation and Strategy
- Partnership working
- More efficient and effective programmes
